



Update on the move...

In September we moved all the mothers and babies and staff from the old ATM compound over to the new land secured for Haven.

It has been a challenging and yet exciting time for us as we set up at our new location. Thankfully there were already some accommodation available and we were able to squish everyone in until some of the containers were completed.



Unfortunately we had to turn away 5 women and babies during these last few months and did our best to find other situations for them or help them from outside as we did not have the accommodation to support them yet.

We now have 2 of the 6 container homes set up and are waiting until January to begin completion of the other 4. By February 2021 we will be able to receive new cases into our care.

RESCUE

Physical, Mental and Emotional health through love, care and support. Teaching and Training to recover skills and make goals for a successful future.

New workshop set up...

One of the biggest challenges of moving has been the relocation of the workshops and small businesses. As most of you would know business takes a while to build up and moving to a new location meant we would have to start all over again. We were concerned about this as providing training and jobs is one of the main things that makes Haven of Grace's program successful and stand out.

But we truly thank God for opening doors for us. We found a shop front to rent for very reasonable price right on the street of the main market! We were able to set up the bakery and cafe there and will be reopening in January. The women have already been testing out the new place and baking and selling the goods right out on the street. We are already seeing a great response from the locals in the area.

We have also begun soap making along with other natural cosmetics and have been able to send these to some friends who have helped us sell them overseas.

Stage 1: Caring for Self and Baby

Stage 2: Child Development and Parenting

Stage 3: Managing Work, Family and Finances

Stage 4: Preparing to leave Haven of Grace

Our goal in helping these women is that they receive support in all areas, physical, mental, emotional and spiritual. We encourage them to set goals and make steps to achieve them. We want to see them break the cycle of poverty and abuse that is often the root issue in these broken families.
